TUITION DISCOUNTS

- 1) \$200 off tuition for the year if paid in full before July 15th. \$100.00 off biannual tuition (\$50.00 from June & \$50.00 from January payment).
- 2) Families of three or more children enrolled are eligible for a 25% discount off the third child, 50% off the fourth and subsequent children from the same family.
- 3) The dual-credit tuition assistance discount will reduce tuition by \$100.00 per course, up to two courses per year maximum, of college tuition paid for qualifying Juniors and Seniors that take approved dual credit college classes in English and Social Studies.

drafting company is a requirement for those families not paying in full or opting for our bi-annual (50%/50%) payment plan. Enrollment in FACTS must be completed before your final MCA enrollment appointment. The tuition balance will be paid in 10 monthly tuition payments starting in August and ending in May. Bi-annual payments are due before July 15th and January 15th. Full tuition payments are due by July 15th.

RENWEB is how parents can get secure access to your child's data (attendance, grades, homework, etc.) via the web. All MCA families can have access to a RENWEB account.

FAMILY LUNCH ACCOUNT PAYMENTS

Family lunch accounts are expected to continually have a positive balance. You can pay in two ways:

- Pay electronically through your RENWEB account
- Deposit cash or checks at the MCA office
